

Pitch & Facilities Usage Policy Aldershot and Farnham HC



Policy no AFHC CP34V4

Aldershot and Farnham Hockey Club's policy is that all members are to take shared responsibility for how the pitches and changing rooms are used and the condition in which these are left in.

It is the responsibility of captains and club officials to ensure team members and visiting teams are following the guidelines stipulated in this policy.

AFHC takes its responsibility to our local communities and stakeholders seriously and as such the following standards apply:

Pitch Usage:

- All hockey goals must be turned to face the fence at the end of each training session/ last game to take place.
- When a dividing pitch net is being used, the central support pole must be in place NB- in high winds this net and pole should not be used.
- All rubbish should be put in the bins provided and the pitch to be checked and cleared of any remaining refuse at the end of training / your game.
- Under no circumstances are dogs or other animals to be allowed onto the pitch or caged area.
- Any damage to the pitch accidental or otherwise should be reported to the Hockey Manager promptly.

Changing Room Usage (at Aldershot Cricket Club):

- The changing room doors must be shut and lights turned out after each team's usage.
- Dogs and other animals are prohibited from being taken in to the changing areas / rooms.
- Changing rooms should be left clean and tidy at the end of each usage with all rubbish put into available waste bins.
- No Astros are to be worn in the main club house area.
